Supervision? members for the	A parent or guardian must accompany and be responsible for all family members for the entire event.
Cost? patches,	\$20 per person for the weekend, (Adults, Cub Scouts and Siblings) Fee covers patches, camping fees and program supplies. \$10 per person for a day pass for Saturday.
Food?	Each unit and family is responsible for its own food for the entire weekend.
What to bring? bring:	Each unit/family is responsible for their own equipment. Suggested items to bring: Tent, ground cloth, tarp or other shelter, cooking equipt. Sleeping bag, blankets, pillow, air mattress or pad. Rain gear, change of clothes, jacket, sweatshirt, durable shoes (Close toed). <u>NO OPEN TOED SHOES. (EVERYONE)</u> Toiletries, tooth paste/brush, towel etc. Hat or cap, water bottle, flashlight, sunscreen, sunglasses, insect repellent, camera.
Do not bring:	Alcohol, firearms, weapons, electronics (radios, TV's, Gameboys, etc.)

Cell phones will only be for adults.

Campsites: Cars may drive to the campsites to unload and load, then they must immediately return to

the parking lot. ONLY Unit trailers may remain at the campsite.
